day from school with their mother waiting for them. They could smell the tea cakes or

supper cooking before they ever reached the back door. Many of you here today are a

the oldest living member of Little Rock Assembly where she served for over 72 years. She

served as Sunday School teacher, Women's leaders, Vacation Bible school worker and

She has scrubbed numerous floors, cooked endless dinners, wrapped hundreds of gifts, heard a ton of excuses and prayed countless prayers. 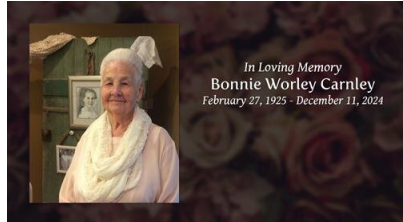
