Doctor Frank Jack Miller of Graceville passed away Tuesday evening, June 1, 2010 at his home. Dr. Jack, as he was affectionately known to all who knew him, was born to the late Dr. R.L. and "Miss" Pearl Miller of Graceville. Dr. Jack attended Graceville High School and graduated from Georgia Military Academy in Atlanta, GA. He attended the University of Florida and the University of Georgia before attending Loyola School of Dentistry in New Orleans, LA. After graduation he served as a Captain in the 185th Army Aviation Medical Dispensary Corp during World War II in Germany. Dr. Jack practiced dentistry for 57 years in Graceville. He was a lifetime member of the Florida and American Dental Associations. For the past 37 years he served on the Board of Directors of the Bank of Jackson County. He was a 50 year member of the Graceville Lions Club and was selected Man of the Year in 2000. Dr. Jack was a lifetime member of the First United Methodist Church of Graceville where he served on many boards and committees. For many years he enjoyed being a cattle rancher and supporting his children in all of their school activities. Dr. Jack was preceded in death by his wife of over 60 years, Hazel Miller, his parents Dr. R.L. (Lee) and Pearl Whitaker Miller and a brother Robert L. Miller, Sr. of New Orleans.
