John Paul Redmon died Tuesday after an extended illness. He was 76. A native of Cambellton, Paul was most at home in the Florida outdoors. He grew up working on farms and ranches across the state with his parents and siblings, eventually settling in Kissimmee and beginning a 32-year career maintaining Florida's roads for the Department of Transportation. Paul continued to work the land throughout his life, planting seasonal gardens and preserving its yield for his family to enjoy throughout the year. And each summer, he took his family on vacation, often to experience the beauty of nature, from the mountains to the coast. He loved to fish, especially with his grandsons, and held fish fries when they returned with a large haul. A vibrant man, Paul enjoyed entertaining, especially at large family gatherings, where he could often be found employing his skills behind the grill. Paul was preceded in death by his parents, Arie Roy and Lena Pearl Redmon, and his sisters, Marynell Brown, Lucille Howard and Doris Kelly.
