Ruby Hulvey Hinson, 80, of Graceville, passed away, Thursday, January 15, 2026, at Southeast Health Medical Center following a brief illness.

Mrs. Ruby was born in Long Island, Alabama on April 1, 1945, to the late Edward B. Almon Hulvey and Flora Belle Farmer Hulvey.

Moving to the Wiregrass area, she was a 1963 graduate of Dothan High School. She loved playing softball. 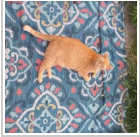
